A Club Records is a very prestigious Record to Hold. It must be remembered that a new Club Record affects two Athletes; the new Record Holder and the previous Record Holder. It is therefore very important that a new Record is only given if the executive can be totally confident that the record was successful and it was achieved under normal conditions. This application form MUST be filled out prior to or on the day that a Club Record is attempted. All of the Criteria to attempt a Club Record MUST be followed to have the Club record approved by the Executive.
